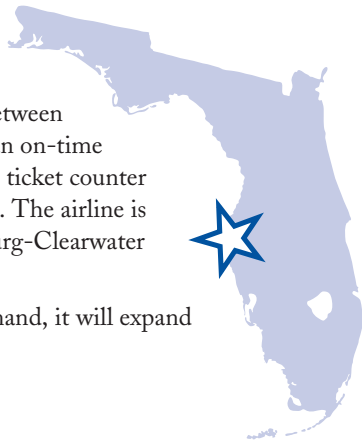

## TAMPA BAY BEGINS!

Allegiant Air began its new non-stop service between South Bend and Tampa Bay on Nov. 17 with an on-time departure of 5:05 p.m. A short ceremony at the ticket counter marked the auspicious beginning of this service. The airline is operating two flights a week to the St. Petersburg-Clearwater International Airport.

Allegiant also announced that, due to high demand, it will expand its Orlando area service in February.

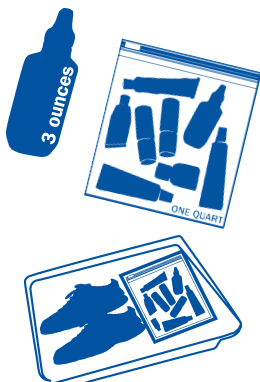

- Make sure all your liquids or gels are kept in **3-ounce** travel-size or smaller containers (more than 3 ounces is permitted in checked baggage).
- Place these containers in a **1 quart-sized**, clear plastic, zip-top bag.
- Place **1 bag per traveler** in the security bin for screening.

## CORPORATE WINGS DRAWS NATIONAL ATTENTION

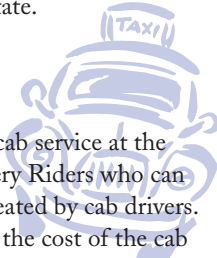
