EXPANDING THE TERMINAL

The South Bend Regional Airport is planning an \$8.5 million expansion and renovation of its terminal. The plan involves combining the two concourses into one efficient space with a single checkpoint. In addition, the airport would like to add several features to the passenger waiting area, including a small gift shop, a coffee bar or snack area, children's play space, an area for business travelers and improved restrooms.

Executive Director John Schalliol noted that the cost of the expansion would not come from property taxes. Rather, it will be funded in part from passenger facility charges currently in existence and from the airport and airway improvement trust fund.

Bids are expected to be let in the spring with project completion in 2010.

SAFETY GRANT RECEIVED

SBRA has received a \$224,000 grant from the FAA as part of the new national Airport Safety Management System (SMS). An SMS is a systematic, proactive safety program that will help assure SBRA's continued provision of quality services while keeping safety as its number one priority. South Bend was one of only three airports to receive the grant following its participation in an FAA pilot program for the development of SMS programs at airports throughout the country.

DISASTER EXERCISE SIMULATES CRASH

On Saturday, Sept. 20, SBRA held a full-scale training exercise, which tested the airport's rescue, firefighting and emergency response procedures. Police, fire and emergency medical personnel as well as the Red Cross and other social service agencies from the community participated, along with Airport Authority personnel.

The exercise provided an opportunity to test the response of airport and other services to a simulated crash of an incoming commercial flight and a FedEx plane on the ground. It involved area fire and police departments as well as ambulance services, the Red Cross and the area's two main hospitals. The exercise was augmented by nearly 100 volunteers who took the parts of meeters, greeters and passengers who did, or did not, survive the crash. The full-scale drill is required by the FAA to be performed every three years.

NEW BUSINESS CENTER

The relocated and renovated Business Center is now open in the terminal. In addition to large, comfortable chairs, the Business Center provides desks where cell phones and laptop computers can be charged and used. You'll find the new center in the space formerly occupied by Travelmore.
